CONDITIONS OF DEWATERING WELL ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

A COPY OF THE WRITTEN NOTICE OR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT SHALL BE AVAILABLE AT THE DRILLING SITE.

- 1) Notice was provided to the State Engineer at least 72 hours prior to construction of the dewatering well(s).
- 2) Construction of the well(s) must be completed within 90 days of the date notice was given to the State Engineer.
- 3) Diversion of water through the dewatering well(s) is limited to temporary dewatering purposes for construction only. Water diverted from the dewatering well(s) must not be used for beneficial purposes and all groundwater pumped must be discharged to the stream system without consumptive use, including evaporative losses. The owner of the well(s) is responsible for obtaining permit(s) and complying with all rules and regulations pertaining to the discharge of fluids produced.
- 4) In accordance with Rule 9.2.2, Well Construction and Yield Estimate Report(s) (form GWS-31) are not required for the construction of a dewatering well unless the well is permitted as a dewatering system. The Water Well Construction Rules (Rules) and well construction forms are available online at: <http://water.state.co.us/>
- 5) Unless a well permit is obtained, the well(s) must be plugged and sealed within 18 months after construction. An Abandonment Report (form GWS-09) must be submitted within 60 days of plugging & sealing to confirm the well is no longer in existence.
- 6) The owner of the well(s) must maintain records of water quality testing and submit this data to the State Engineer upon request.
- 7) The above dewatering well (DW) number, owner's structure name, and well owner's name and address must be provided on all well permit application(s), well construction reports, and abandonment reports.
- 8) THIS ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF NOTICE DOES NOT INDICATE THAT WELL PERMIT(S) CAN BE APPROVED.
- 9) IF WELLS WILL NOT BE CONSTRUCTED UNDER THIS NOTICE WITHIN 90 DAYS, PLEASE WRITE, "NO WELLS CONSTRUCTED" ON A COPY OF THE ACKNOWLEDGED NOTICE WITH THE FILE NUMBER AND EITHER MAIL IT THE ADDRESS BELOW OR EMAIL IT TO dwpermitsonline@state.co.us
