This application can only be used to cancel (in whole or in part) a Determination of Water Right for the Dawson, Denver, Arapahoe or Laramie-Fox Hills aquifers that was approved by the Ground Water Commission pursuant to Section 37-90-107(7), C.R.S. **INSTRUCTIONS – APPLICATION TO CANCEL A DETERMINATION OF WATER RIGHT**

**ITEM 1 – DETERMINATION NUMBER AND AQUIFER** - Indicate the number of the Determination of Water Right and the aquifer for which the application is being submitted.

**ITEM 2 - APPLICANT INFORMATION** - Provide the applicant's name, telephone number, mailing address and email where all correspondence will be sent.

**ITEM 3 – EVIDENCE OF OWNERSHIP OF THE WATER RIGHT** – If applicant is not the same party to whom the Determination of Water Right was originally issued, a copy of a deed must be provided showing that the applicant owns the water right that is being canceled.

**ITEM 4 – VERIFICATION OF UNDERSTANDING** – The applicant must indicate an understanding that the water being canceled from this Determination reverts to being an unvested, inchoate right, re-attached to the overlying acres based on ownership of the overlying land.

**ITEM 5 – PORTION OF RIGHT BEING CANCELLED** – The applicant must indicate whether the right is being canceled in whole or in part.

If the right is being canceled in part, the amount being canceled and the overlying land area from beneath which the water is being canceled must be indicated.

If the right is being canceled in part from beneath only a portion of the overlying land, the number of acres, legal description and map of the portion of the overlying land area from beneath which the water is requested to be canceled must be provided.

For Determinations that did not exclude water beneath the overlying land from the Determination, obtaining well permits for future proposed small capacity wells on the overlying land requires cancelling in whole or in part, water that is allocated by the Determination.

**ITEM 6 - EXISTING WELL PERMITS ISSUED, AND AMOUNT OF WATER THAT HAS BEEN DIVERTED, PURSUANT TO THE DETERMINATION OF WATER RIGHT** – Existing well permits issued pursuant to the Determination may be canceled, and wells existing under those permits may need to be plugged unless issued new well permits.

Amounts of water remaining available for withdrawal from beneath the overlying land, whether pursuant to any portion of the Determination not canceled or reverting to the overlying acres based on ownership of the overlying land, may be reduced by amounts of water that were withdrawn pursuant to the Determination while the Determination was valid.

**ITEM 7 - SIGNATURE OF APPLICANT** – The application must be signed. If the applicant is a company, corporation, organization, etc, the statement must be signed by an official of the company who must indicate his/her position or capacity that grants authorization to sign. An applicant's authorized agent or attorney may sign the application if a statement signed by the applicant is submitted with the application authorizing the person to act as agent for the specific purpose of applying to cancel the determination of water right.
